I wish all of you and yours a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year.

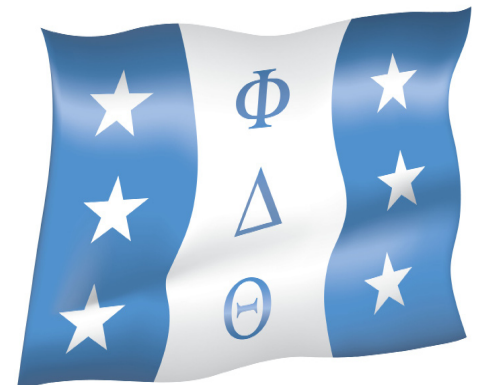
